

Directions for the synagogue

- The ark is in the centre of the room on the back wall. Just below the eagle on the Ark is where the 10 commandments go. They are written on two stone arcs.
- Inside the ark is where the Torah scrolls are kept. This is to keep them safe and free from being destroyed as they are considered very special.
- North of this and on the ceiling is the Ner Tamid. It hangs from the roof and is always lit.
- In the centre of the room on the floor is the Bimah.
- Slightly west of this is the Rabbi's podium. There is also a microphone on top of the podium so that when the Rabbi speaks everyone can hear him.
- North of the ark but south of the Ner Tamid is the Star of David. It is in the middle of the two on the back wall. There is also a Star of David on the outside of the synagogue above the arched doorways in a circle.
- On the inside of the synagogue, on the eastern walls and the western walls are two stained glass windows each. On the outside of the synagogue are 4 stained glass windows also; two on the left-hand side and two on the right.
- You must draw a stained-glass window on the outside of the synagogue directly above the arched doorway.
- The Menorah is found within every synagogue. But it can be found anywhere within the synagogue. Place the Menorah where you feel it best fits.
