**Choose an activity each week.**

**Personal, social and emotional**

Happy healthy Me.

- Talk with your adult about the things you need to keep you healthy. (Exercise/balanced diet/sleep etc.).
- Plan a healthy lunchbox with your adult-draw your healthy box.
- Can you talk about your favourite food, why do you like it?

**Mathematics**

- Have a try at writing your numbers up to 10.
- Collect a group of 10 objects - can you split them into two groups, how many have you got in each group? Can you make different groups each time.
- Enjoy playing a game with your adult, it could be dominoes, snakes and ladders, twister

**Communication, Language and Literacy**

- Can you find some stories about animals – ‘The very hungry caterpillar’, ‘The very quiet cricket’ are lovely ones. What happens in the story? Can you talk about it with your adult.
- Can you share your favourite nursery rhyme, can you do the actions as well?
- If you go for a walk can you listen to the different sounds that you can hear, can you hear any birds?

**Writing/Reading**

- Can you play eye spy outside
- Keep practicing holding your pencil correctly and making marks on paper, if you can write your name or trace over it that would be brilliant
- Have a try at writing the letters from the sounds we have learnt – can you write them in cursive?

**Expressive arts and design**

- Have a look at pictures of blossom on trees on the internet. What different colours can you see? If you have some paint can you try and make the colours of the blossom – what colour do you need to add to make the colours lighter?
- Decorate your own Easter egg – can you draw different patterns on your egg? You might want to use paint if you have any.
- Can you make an Easter card for your family?

**Knowledge and Understanding of the World**

- Go on a walk in your local area, can you see if there are any signs of spring? Can you see any flowers starting to grow or if there are any buds on the trees?
- Can you try a new piece of fruit or a new vegetable, did you like it or not?
