Personal, social and emotional

- Go on a number hunt in your house. What is the biggest and smallest number you can find?
- Can you make a repeating pattern using your toys?
- Have a try at writing your numbers up to 20.
- Draw your family in their height order.
- Write a number on a card. Can you say what comes before and after that number?

Communication, Language and Literacy

- Listen to your favourite stories, can you retell these stories to someone in your family?
- Draw your favourite character and write some words to describe them.
- Play 'I spy' with your adult. You can play it inside and outside.

Writing/Reading

- Practice holding your pencil correctly, can you draw write both your names and some of your HFW?
- Draw and label a picture of your favourite party foods.
- Draw and label object for each letter in your name.

Expressive arts and design

- Design and build a fairy tale castle out of household waste.
- Paint or draw a book cover from your favourite book.
- If it snows go out and build a snowman or make a snow angel.
- Build a little ice house for one of the 3 little pigs.

Knowledge and Understanding of the World

- Look at some different vegetables-can you find out where they come from and how they grow?
- Draw or paint your favourite fruit and vegetables.
- Can you help an adult make some porridge for the 3 bears? Can you draw some pictures and writing to show how you did this?
