Maths




Recognising numbers 0-10 in and out of order. Ask your adult to write the numbers on small pieces of paper and hide them around the house. Can you find the numbers and put them into the correct order?

Shapes - what shapes can you spot in your house?



Literacy

It is quite long so watch it a little bit at a time if you would rather.

With your adult can you talk about what you have watched, can you remember what the characters are called?

We are looking at how Kay might be feeling when he gets taken away. Can you think of some words to describe this? Ask your adult to make a list of the words.

Letters - We have been learning lots of sounds before Christmas, can you look at these sounds s, a, t and p and tell your adult what they are and show them the actions for the sounds. It is okay if you have forgotten them, ask your adult to remind you and then practice recognising them each day. You can make your own flashcards if you want and then these can be added to each week as we cover more letters.

In our phonics we are also looking at listening to sounds - can you go on phonics play and play welcome to the zoo, can you guess the sounds that you can hear?

If possible ask your adults if they will make you some ice cubes, you can then explore holding these in your hands - how do they feel? What happens to the ice cubes as they are in your hand? Do they start to melt? Why do you think this is happening?
