Try it inside the house and outside or looking out of the window.

## Maths -Measuring



Using your hand or foot draw an object and measure how long it is using hand spans or footsteps (toe to toe).

If you have a ruler a grown up could show how to measure small items in your house and garden.

## Topic/Literacy - Seasons

(All these activities are on Purple Mash -but you can complete them on paper)

Describe spring lambs-what sound do they make?

What colour are they? What do you think they smell like?



## Art

Draw or paint four trees, one for each season.

Spring-blossom.

Summer-leaves/fruit/flowers.

Autumn-what colour are the leaves on this tree.

Winter-do we need leaves on some of the trees or, do they all lose their leaves?

What do we call trees that lose their leaves, or those that keep their leaves?

Can you make a weather map -using the symbols for different kinds of weather?
