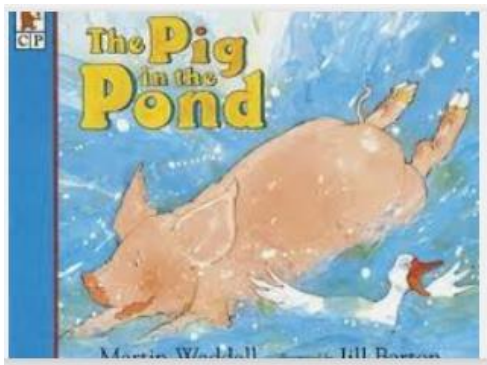
We are not setting any 2Do's as I would like you to choose the activities that you like and challenge your self to try and complete the next level.

Literacy/Topic



This week's story is 'The Pig in the Pond', [listen to the story](#).



Can you research pigs?

- + What do they like to eat?
- + Where do they live?
- + Can you draw your own picture of the pig from the story, talk and write about your favourite part?
- + Do you have a favourite animal from the story?

Play guess the animal - Can you describe an animal from the story for an adult to guess? Think about the colour of the animal, how many legs it has, is it big/little, what sound does it make?

Put on your old clothes for this really messy activity!

If you can go outside and collect some mud in a bucket/container - explore adding water to the mud - what happens to the mud as you add more water? Can you use the mud to model a pig?

Can you sound out the word - **P-I-G**, what sounds can you hear?

Have a go at writing down the sounds that you can hear, have a go with the names of other animals.

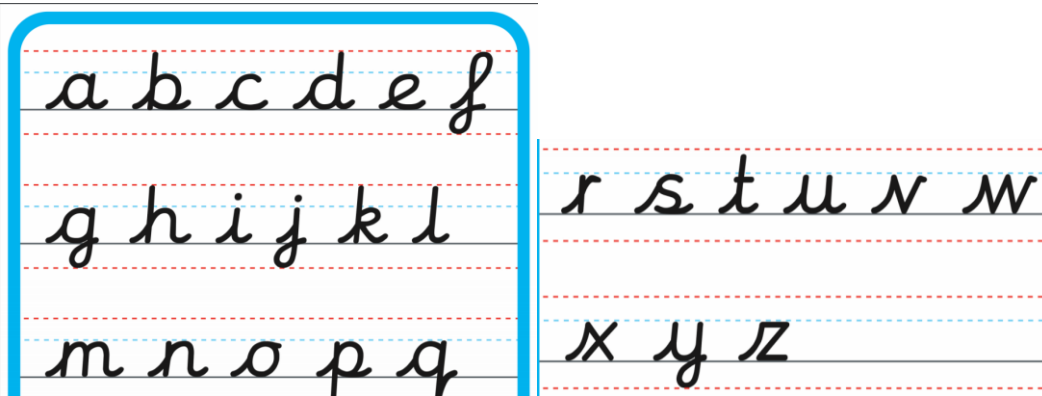
