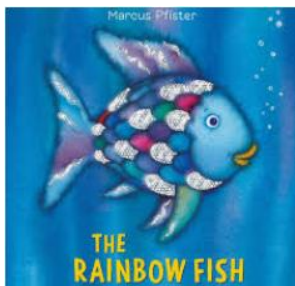
We are not setting any 2Do's as I would like you to choose the activities that you like and challenge your self to try and complete the next level.

This week's story is 'The Rainbow Fish', click on the link to [listen to the story](#).

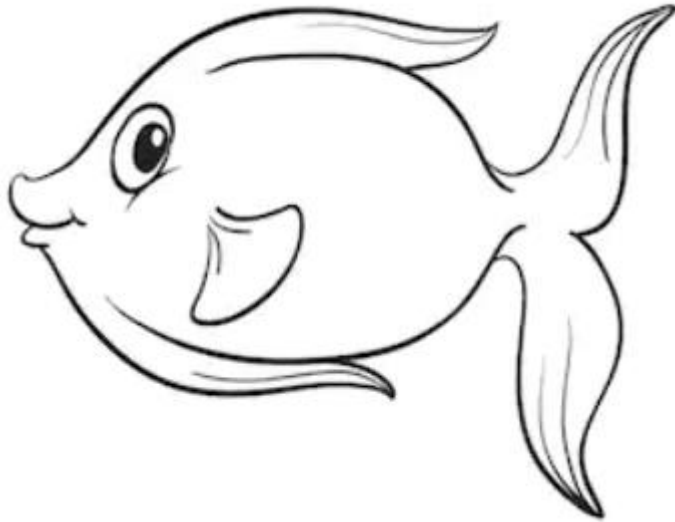


Talk to your grown up about the story, how did the rainbow fish feel? Was he happy/sad? What things make you feel happy and what may make you feel sad?

This week we are going to look at rhyming words - how many words can you think of that rhyme with fish? They can be real words or made up words - have a go at trying to write them in a list.

Can you put any of them into a sentence?

Can you find some coloured pieces of paper and have a go at cutting it into pieces then decorate your fish? There's a template below you can use if you would like to.



You could also have a go at drawing round your hand and turning into a fish 😊



If you have any blue and white paint, explore what happens to the blue paint when you keep adding white? If you have black paint try adding that to the blue paint - what happens then?

Sorting:- The rainbow fish lives in water - can you explore with water - it can be at bath time or ask an adult to fill a bowl up and you could take it outside - have an explore at seeing what objects float or sink - can you guess before you test them.

Keep on working on your phonics😊

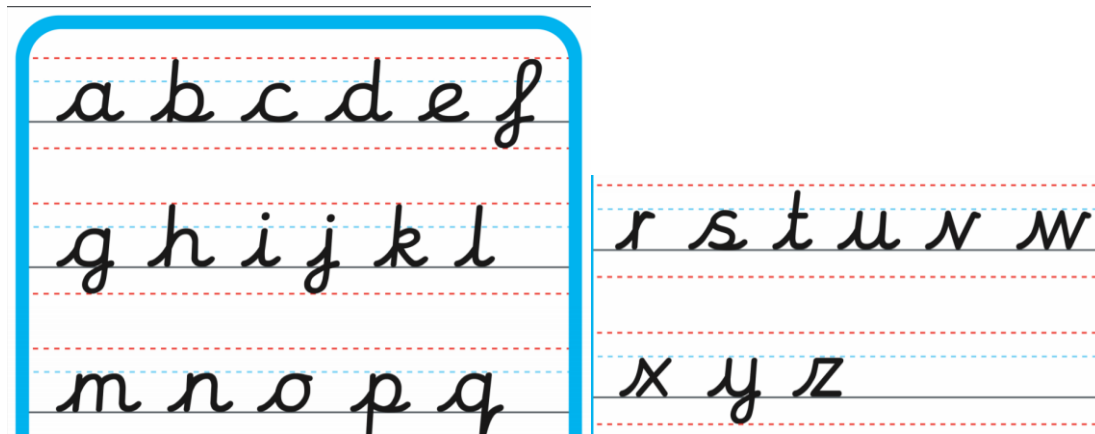
