Reading/Writing



The reading this week is on Purple Mash and is an activity that you will need to do with a little help.

On the home page of Purple Mash, go to games, then English and onto Talking Stories .Explore the story of Sally's Seaside Adventure. If you understand the story, then you should be able to answer the questions.

You could write about your own seaside adventure, drawing some pictures and writing a sentence under them. Remember when you need to use a capital letter (ABC) and full stop. Don't forget fingers paces between your words.



Keep on reading and writing your high frequency words, how many do you know now?

Don't forget your phonics

Write a list of words that start with Ch-chocolate

Sh-shell

Th-think



Can you put any of them into a simple sentence-I love to eat chocolate!

Maths - looking at all the different ways we can make 10/20.

Write the numbers 1-10 on squares of paper.

Put them in a pile and turn them over.

Take it in turns to turn one over,if you can say the number that when added to your number makes 10.Then you win the card.

Repeat with numbers up to 20. **Challenge up to 30.**

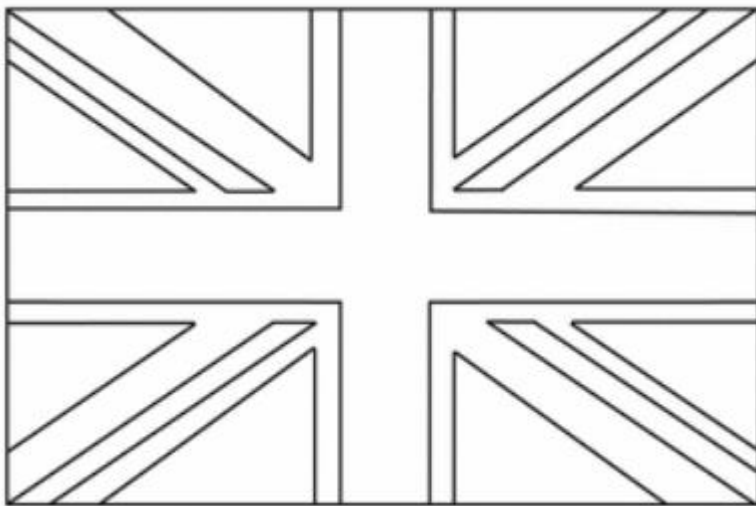
VE Day
