Dear Parents,

Thank you all for the supportive phone calls and emails we have received following the school closure announcements Monday evening. All parents who require children to attend the school because they are critical workers should by now have contacted the school and the children have been placed on our registers, for the days that you work. Children who attend school will need to wear school uniform and bring in water bottles, reading books and workbooks. School dinners will be available to order through School Grid, all pre orders will be removed from the system at midnight tonight. **If your child is in Nursery or has a keyworker place you will need to reorder your meals from tomorrow (Thursday) morning please.**

This week's home learning will be for the children to start working through the pack of worksheets that have already been provided in case of a lockdown. Reception and Year 1 will be able to collect their new packs today, and Year 2 their new homework books.

There will be a range of different tasks such as reading, writing, art activities. Work for years 1 – 4 will also be set from the workbooks (sent home earlier this year) for Maths and English. Please can I ask that you keep in mind that the class teachers will also be teaching those pupils who remain in school. We have larger numbers in school compared to the first school closures and the nursery has remained open too. You can e-mail your child's class teacher at any time and they will reply when they are able, also call the school if you need to at any time.
