Harvest Festival

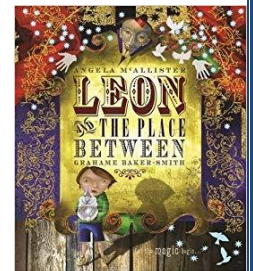
Thank you to all who donated harvest produce for our Harvest Festival today. All the produce will be donated to the Uttoxeter Food Bank to support families within our local community.
