Dear Parents/Carers,

I just wanted to extend my thanks to all parents who followed the County Council guidance to get their child a PCR test following positive cases in school. This has helped identify a further 3 cases in the school, all in children with no symptoms, and hopefully help prevent the spread of infection. Your co-operation at this time is very much appreciated.

In our meeting this week we discussed charging for breakfast club sessions if pupils are unable to attend whilst awaiting test results. It was agreed, in line with our terms and conditions, that all pre booked sessions would be chargeable in the event of any non-attendance. This has been decided to ensure our breakfast club facility remains financially viable and continues to run as a valuable asset to all our families.

Tynsel Parkes CE Primary Academy Parents' Evening - Online Appointment Booking

I would like to invite you to attend our Parents' Evening on Tuesday 2nd November or Thursday 4th November between 4pm and 5:30pm. This is an important event and provides you with an opportunity to speak to your children's teachers about their progress and how the children have settled into the new school year.

Since we are still unable to invite parents onto the school site, due to the ongoing COVID restrictions, Tynsel Parkes will continue to use the virtual system as followed last half term, the system allows you to choose your appointment times, once you have booked a time you will receive an email confirming your appointments.

We will send a link to your mobile phone or email address which will take you to our online booking system to select a time convenient for you. Please follow these simple steps to book your slot:

1. Click the link that you receive through text and/or email to take you to the confirmation page. You will need internet access to do this.
2. Enter your child's first name to continue. If you have more than one child, any of their first names will work.
3. Next you will be taken to the booking page. This will show your children alongside all of the teachers that you can book in with.
4. Click 'Please Choose' to be shown a list of available times that you can click to book. This will even give you the option to add any notes that you might want the teacher to see before the meeting.
5. After you have entered any notes, please click 'Book this Slot' to complete your booking. When the button has turned green you know your booking has been made.
6. At any time before the Parents' Evening, you can click the link on your phone or email again to check your booking time or even un-book by clicking the green booked button.

You must be on time for your appointments, teachers will only have a 5 minute appointment with you and then the call will immediately go to the next appointment for the teacher, ensuring the evening does not overrun.



Covid-19 - PCR Testing:

We have had quite a few enquiries this week regarding PCR testing and thought this information may be useful. If you are contacted by the school and advised to get a PCR test you need to book a test here <https://www.gov.uk/get-coronavirus-test>

If your child has no symptoms you need to select the following option "I've been told to get a test by my local council", see image below:

Postal tests are much slower than booking a test at a local drive through testing centre. Parents who have used the local drive through testing centres have generally had their PCR results back either overnight or the next day meaning children are missing 1-2 days of school.

There are always tests available in Stoke and Stafford and at certain times there are mobile testing stations too which are usually much closer like Cheadle and Denstone.

We look for support from parents to minimise spread in the setting by not sending pupils to school if their siblings have tested positive. This is based on the likelihood that the sibling will become infectious due to being a household contact. The more time a child/adult spends with a positive case the greater the likelihood of them having COVID. We would also encourage the pupil to get a PCR test.

Flu Spray - 1st November 2021 Reception to Year 4:

Information regarding the Flu Spray has been sent out via Parent Pay to all children in Reception to Year 4 this week.
