Personal, Social & Emotional Development

We will be;-

Taking turns with each other when playing with the toys and games.

Building relationships with our friends in the classroom and playground

Being aware of and understanding our own feelings other people's feelings.

Understanding the difference between right and wrong.

Communication and Language

We will be:-

Working our way through the story each week taking a different section of the story. We will be learning different words from the story and trying to use them when we speak.

We will also be meeting different characters from the story and trying to ask questions using how and why they do certain things in story.

We will be trying to extend our sentences and making them longer.

Mathematics

Looking at the value of numbers 0-10 - use Number blocks to understand how we can make different numbers.

Completing simple number addition practically and then move onto recording them in their maths books. Simple number problems - do practically using lots of mathematical language - e.g. Sarah went to the shop and brought 2 apples and 3 bananas - how much fruit did she have all together?

Can you find one more than a given number?
Use Numicon to look at the pattern of numbers

Physical Development

We will be:-

Give opportunities when outside to move in different ways using the different outside equipment. Climbing up and down, through things and exploring on the balance bikes.

Making our dominant hand stronger by using one handed tools and equipment.

Literacy

We will be:-

Continue learning our speed set sounds one and two from the Read Write Inc scheme

Trying to form our letters correctly, holding our pencil the right way.

Recognising our name and beginning to try to right the sounds in our names.

Understanding the World

We will be:-

Exploring the solar system and learning the names of the planets

Create our own space journey making our own spaceships.

We will be looking at what we would need to take with us if we visited different places.

Expressive Arts and Designs

We will be:-

- Making our own jetpacks using plastic bottles and tin foil.
- Learn the song 'Going into Space' and add instruments
- To use the instruments to copy a repeating pattern.

How you can help your child at home

- Encourage your child to talk about their day ask them questions about what they have been doing .Help them to recognise and write their name.
- Share your child's reading book and library book with them, talk about what they can see in the illustrations.
