English

This half term Year 1 will be reading Man on the Moon (A Day in the Life of Bob) by Simon Bartram, Funny Bones by Janet and Allan Ahlberg and Gigantosaurus by Jonny Duddle.

We will use pictures to find out information about a character, write predictive sentences, and find out information about a character by asking questions before writing a character profile. We will map out, retell and role play stories before planning and writing our own stories.







PE

Tuesday: Athletics and Multi Skills Children to bring kit and change in school.

History, Geography, Art, D&T, Computing and Music

History: This half term we will be learning to explain how some people have helped us to have better lives. We will learn about the lives of Neil Armstrong and Christopher Columbus. We will find out all about the race for space and the discovery of the new world.

Art: Exploring shape, line and colour: mixing and painting with secondary colours, using circles to create abstract compositions. We will also learn to draw dinosaurs in the style of Jonny Duddle.

RE: In RE we will consider the big question: How can I make a difference in the world? We will look at, respond to, and learn about caring for our world and understand that we are part of a wider global community.

PSHE: Me in the World We will recognise that living things have needs and that we have responsibilities to meet them.

We will consider social and moral dilemmas and recognise the needs people have.

Music: By the Sea - We will be exploring different ways that we can use our bodies to create music and different ways of using our voice to create effects

Mathematics

Number and Place Value: Count, read and write numbers to 100 in numerals; count in multiples of twos, fives and tens Addition and Subtraction: Solve one-step problems that involve addition and subtraction, using concrete objects and pictorial representations, and missing number problems such as 7 = [] - 9

Multiplication and division: Solve one-step problems involving multiplication and division, by calculating the answer using concrete objects, pictorial representations and arrays with the support of the teacher

Number - fractions

Recognise, find and name a half as one of two equal parts of an object, shape or quantity

Recognise, find and name a quarter as one of four equal parts of an object, shape or quantity

Geometry - position and direction

Describe position, direction and movement, including whole, half, quarter and three-quarter turns

Science

Animals including humans: Identifying animals.

This half term we will be finding out all about mammals, birds, reptiles, amphibians and fish. We will think about the needs of different pets and become familiar with the terms carnivore, herbivore and omnivore.
