



Curriculum Overview - The Three Little Pigs.

English

This term we will be reading fiction and non fiction books about changes. We will be using all our books as a stimulus for writing fiction and non fiction.



History, Geography, Art, D&T, Computing and Music

Art: Landscapes and Cityscapes. We will learn about the bright colours and bold brushstrokes used by Claude Monet, Vincent van Gogh, and Jean Metzinger when painting landscapes and cityscapes. We will think about the similarities and differences between the works of these different artists, making paintings, drawings, and mosaic art, inspired by the three artists.
RE: We will be investigating the big question "What do Muslims believe?"

PSHE: Safety and Changing body - Know a number of adults in school.

Know that they should speak to an adult if they are ever worried or feel uncomfortable about another adult.

Understand ways to keep safe and not get lost and know the steps to take if they do get lost

Computing: We will learn about safe log-ins, our work area, Purple Mash Topics and Tools.

Geography: We will be exploring what our local area is like, learning to recognise human and physical features of our own locality.

Music: We will be looking at timbre and rhythmic patterns. We will be representing the different characters using the instruments

Mathematics

Number and Place Value: Within 20

Use numbers to 50 in sequences by putting them in order from small to big. Count and group numbers in tens to 50. Count tens and ones and explore their place value. Begin to use a place value chart to understand the value of numbers.

Addition and Subtraction: Within 20

Compare numbers using mathematical language. Write equations to show the difference between numbers and objects. Solving comparison problems. Use the 'make ten' strategy to find the differences between numbers.

Materials: This term we are looking at materials, properties of materials and their uses i.e., what materials we use and why. We will perform simple tests, to compare a variety of everyday materials on the basis of their simple properties.
