



Curriculum Overview - The Three Little Pigs.

English

This term we will be reading fiction and non fiction books about changes. We will be using all our books as a stimulus for writing fiction and non fiction.



History, Geography, Art, D&T, Computing and Music

D&T: We will be designing, making and evaluating a car that moves.

RE: Salvation. We will discuss how the Easter story is one of sadness, followed by great happiness. We will retell the events of Palm Sunday, Good Friday and Jesus' crucifixion, and how Jesus rises to new life on Easter Sunday. We will learn about traditions linked with these special days.

PSHE: Citizenship :- We will be explaining why the class and school rules are important. Discussing the different needs of a range of pets. Describing some of the needs of babies and young children. Recognising some similarities and differences between themselves and others

Computing: Animated Story Books. Drawing and Creating, Animation, Sounds and More! Making a Story.

History: History of transport, we will be looking at how transport has evolved over the years. Also asking the question are all the changes good changes?

Music: Animals - We will be looking at different types of classical music and learning all about dynamics (loud and quiet) and tempo (fast and slow)

Mathematics

Number and Place Value: Within 5 Recognising, reading and write numbers to 50. Exploring the components of numbers within 50 - counting in tens and ones using a place value chart. Apply knowledge of number bonds - count in tens and ones using a place value chart, Dienes and number lines.

Length and Height:- We will be exploring the differences in lengths of various objects, finding the difference between height and using the correct vocabulary to explain our findings

Mass and Volume:- We will be exploring heavier and lighter, full and empty. Learning how to compare volume. We will be measuring capacity and comparing capacity.
