Wednesday 4th September	School term starts for children, Welcome back!

Wednesday 11th September	Meet the teacher meetings: The meetings are aimed at parents and carers to gain more information about the year group your child is moving in to and the work the children will be carrying out. It is an opportunity for you to ask questions and meet your child's class teacher as well as see the classroom your child will be learning in this year. The meetings will last about 30 minutes. Uniforms:

All pupils are to wear full uniform, this includes a school tie and black shoes. **(Please label all clothing including coats)**. If your child has their ears pierced, they should only wear plain gold studs and these are to be removed for PE lessons. PE T-Shirts should be plain white. Thank you.

Health & Safety Reminders:

Children should wait with parents and carers before and after school, please do not allow your children to use the play equipment or ride their scooters. This is to ensure the safety of all at these busy times of the day.

Water Bottles and School Lunches:

Children will need to bring a filled water bottle with their name clearly labelled- this will go home daily to be washed and brought back the following day. (These should be plastic bottles, due to health and safety reasons).

All Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 children are entitled to Universal Free School Meals. Remember to order school lunches through SchoolGrid. Nursery, Year 3 and Year 4 are welcome to order a lunch at the price of £2.40 for Nursery children and £2.87 for all other year groups, there is a lovely choice of hot meals available for the children to enjoy.

Book bags & Pencil Cases:

Please can I ask that children do not attach more than one keyring (if wanted as a way for the child to identify their bag). Last year children were bringing lots of keyrings and this meant they were not fitting in the children's trays.

Children do not need to bring their own resources to school, as a school we provide all the writing equipment and resources needed. Please can the children keep their own items at home for safe keeping and use for their weekly homework activities.
