Curriculum Overview - Why is our world so wonderful?

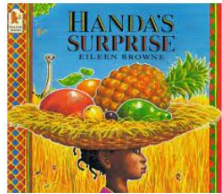

English

This half term our class texts will be *Handa's Surprise* by Eileen Browne and *Meerkat Mail* by Emily Gravett. We will be learning about proper nouns and question sentences.



History, Geography, Art, D&T, Computing and Music

Geography: We will be identifying and comparing the features of hot and cold countries. We will look at similarities and differences in the weather.

Art: Our wonderful world. Landscapes and cityscapes. We will learn about the bright colours and bold brushstrokes used by Claude Monet.

D&T: Cooking and nutrition: Making smoothies. We will learn to distinguish between fruits and vegetables and where they grow, taste and choose ingredients to design a fruit and vegetable smoothie, and matching packaging.

RE: We will consider the big question: How can I make a difference in the world? We will look at, respond to, and learn about caring for our world and understand that we are part of a wider global community.

PSHE: Economic Wellbeing. We will be looking at money and how we can keep our money safe. We will also be looking at the role of banks, spending and saving money.

Music: Under the Sea. We will be exploring different ways that we can use our bodies to create music and different ways of using our voice to create effects.

Computing: Online Safety. We will be learning what personal information is and how to stay safe when using the internet. We will discuss how to be kind online and what to do if something makes us feel worried.

Mathematics

Position and Direction: Describe turns and different positions including left, right, forwards, backwards, above and below, as well as using the language associated with ordinal numbers.

Number and Place Value (within 100): Count, read and write numbers to 100 in numerals; count in multiples of twos, fives and tens.

Money: Unitising money, recognising coins, recognising notes and counting in coins.

Time: Understanding key vocabulary that relates to time and daily routines such as before and after. Sequencing the days of the and months of the year. Understanding the comparative length of hours, minutes and seconds. Telling the time to the hour and half hour.

PE

Monday: Fitness

Monday: Ball games

Children to bring PE kit and change in school.

Science

Animals including humans: We will learn to identify and label basic human body parts and explore each of the five senses.

How you can help at home

- **Reading:** Please read 5 times per week with your child and record it in their diary.
- **Spellings** - A list of 5-10 spelling words (linked to the sounds of the week) will be sent home every Friday, please practise spelling these words with your child during the week and we will test in school on the following Friday.
